- Lady of the Day 35 years & over
- Gent of the Day 18 years & over

Entrants enter in good faith and their attitude during and after judging is expected to be one of fun. TTC provides the opportunity for participation in FOTF and acknowledge that without the generous support of sponsors and volunteers the event would not take place. Proof of age must be provided if requested.

Entrants in the Local Lady or Gent of the Day category must provide a NSW Driver's License or Service NSW photo card as proof of residence if requested. Must reside within Temora Shire. The winner of the Local Lady or Gent of the day will be ineligible to compete in any further categories.

Entries will be taken in person at the VIP area set up for judging, Temora Showground, prior to race 1 on the night of 13 January 2024.

Entrants are to provide a completed registration form and will be given a number.

Registration forms will be available on the night.

There will be a panel of 3 judges. There will be prizes for each category.

The winners will be selected on the judge's opinions and the judge's decision will be final. Directors of the Temora Trotting Club, their immediate families and the immediate families of the judges will not be eligible to enter. Immediate family is defined as a spouse, de facto partner, child, parent or sibling of the director or judge.

The judging panel will base their decision on the following criteria:

Style and originality

Appropriateness of the outfit for the the individual

Attention to detail with accessories

Understanding and interpretation of the current fashion trends

Grooming and deportment.

Suitability of the outfit for the race day.
